Submission #1: Script & Storyboard Contract Students will write a script detailing the conversations between actors & actresses in their scene. They will draw also draw the different views in each scene. Trick The Viewer: As the student writes their script, at least once in a scene, the student must trick the viewer into believing something is occurring that really is not occurring.	50pts.
Submission #2.0: Present Raw Footage iMovie Filming must be completed. Invite Mr. Harrington to view the raw footage you imported.	50pts.
Submission #2.1: Present Photoshop File At the same time that you present the raw footage that you imported into iMovie, invite Mr. Harrington to view the original Photoshop files (.psd) that you created to edit the images that you intend to use in your video. The images you intend to use should be visible.	20pts.
Submission #3: Present Flash Animation Present the Flash Animation that will be in your video.	50 pts.
Submission #4: Your Finished Video You must have Mr. Harrington review your final film. The Scene that you created will be checked for: 1. Did you fulfill the contract (50pts), 2. How is the quality of the video you created (50pts.)? We will be looking to see if the Quality Standards have been met. Do your scenes actually look real? Has all the green screen been removed? How is the audio? Can you here the actors?	100 pts.
