

Photoshop: Layers & Selection

Model (55 pts.)



<p>Step #1: Folder Create a folder on your desktop. Title it: “RLSAthletics_Photoshop”</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #2: Acquire Images Go online to Google Images, find and save an image of a basketball, a football and a soccerball. Also, find the Blue Devil seen above in the model to the folder you created in Step #1.</p>	10 pts.
<p>Step #3: Canvas Open Photoshop. Create a New Canvas. Set the canvas to 8 inches wide by 6 inches high / 72 dpi / RGB / transparent. Save this Photoshop project to the folder you created on the desktop. Title it, “RLSAthletics_Photoshop_YourName.”</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #4: Text & Bend Text Add Text: “R.L.S. Athletics.”</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #5: Import Images Import the four images to the canvas.</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #6: Remove Background Colors from the Image & Understanding Selection Tools Select the image and remove any background colors.</p>	10 pts.
<p>Step #7: Resize Resize the image so that each of the sports balls are a different size: the football should be the largest and the soccer ball should be the smallest of the three. The Blue Devil should appear approximately the same size as you see it on the model.</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #8: Drop Shadow & Bevel Bevel & Drop Shadow the title “R.L.S. Athletics.” Then, add a drop shadow to</p>	5 pts.
<p>Step #9: Trim (or Crop) Canvas The canvas must be reduced (Trim or Crop!) to match the size of the image.</p>	5 pts.
<p>Finally: How To Compress & Export An Image After you create the image in Photoshop, you must compress it and export it so that it can be used by other applications</p>	5 pts.
