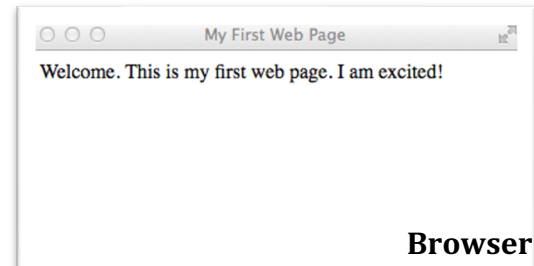

### A Helpful Hint:

Anytime you finish writing code or make changes to your code, you must always "Save".

If something goes wrong..."Edit/Undo!"

### To Save:

On a PC, Save: File Name: "MyFirstWebPage.html"

Save as type: Text Document (.txt)

*(I save it to a folder that I create on the desktop)*

### To View Your Web Page

- Open your browser. Now find the file and open it  
*(MM/File/Open...)*
- You must always refresh your browser after making any changes to a web page.

**On a Mac**, in order to save this page created by "Text Edit" as a web page:

- Select Main Menu/Format: 'Make Plain Text'
- Select 'File' -> 'Save.'
- Save the file as: 'MyFirstWebPage.html'
  - Make sure you add the ".html"
  - Deselect, "If no extension is provided, use .txt."
- You will be asked if you want to use '.html' ... YES!

**On a Mac**, in order to edit a web page using "Text Edit" :

- Open Text Edit / File / Preferences
  - New Document: select "Plain Text" & "Wrap To Page"
  - Open and Save: select "Display HTML files as Html code."
