This weekend, Carpy Gang trounced Calistoga 28-3 in the championship game played in St. Helena. This is just one of many championship trophies the team has brought home, year after year after year. Carpy Gang began in 1952 by David Caryp so that St. Helena boys would have greater exposure to football prior to entering high school. Before this time, St. Helena performed poorly in football against other teams. But Carpy Gang changed all this. David Carpy, a former collegiate player contacted many of his friends, who also played in college.
